




If your vertigo is caused by an infection, antibiotics or steroids may be given. Sometimes doctors recommend antihistamines, such as Antivert (meclizine), Benadryl (diphenhydramine), or Dramamine. The injections usually contain a corticosteroid medication and a local anesthetic. Often, you can receive one at your doctor's office. Because of potential side effects, the number of shots you can get in a year

generally is limited.



Dizziness or lightheadedness; indigestion, could be the side effects of cortisone. Please seek medical attention for conditions that you feel such as change in taste, feeling like metal taste in the mouth & specially pain at the injection site, the doc who prescribed the injection should be the best person to address this question & provide. Cortisone (anti-inflammatory steroid) medications are given to reduce the symptoms. Injections of steroids into the space behind the ear drum (intratympanic steroids) can help reduce the long-term hearing loss of labyrinthitis. The injections must be done in the first 14 days after the onset of symptoms. Vestibular Neuronitis
